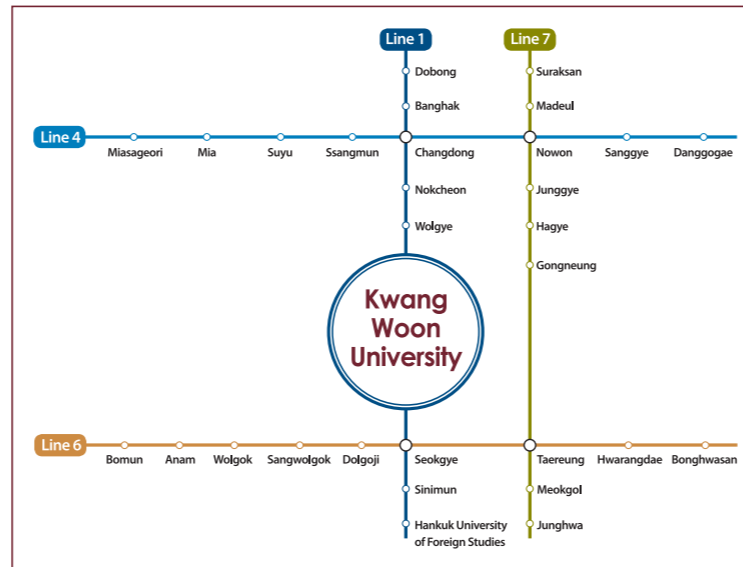

Subway

- Line 1 : (Incheon, Suwon - Seoul Station - Cheongnyangni-Uijeongbu) Get off at Kwangwoon University station and walk 6 minutes.
- Line 6 : (Eungam - Bonghwasan) Get off at Seokgye Station and walk 10 minutes from Exit 1.
- Line 7 : (Dobong - Nowon - Gunja - Konkuk University - Cheongdam - Express Bus Terminal - Onsu) If taking Line 7, transfer at Taereung station to Line 6, get off at Seokgye station, and walk 10 minutes from Exit 1

Korean Language Regular Program

Why Kwangwoon?

Convenient transportation and location

- Located in Seoul, Korea
- Very convenient transportation (Line1 Kwangwoon Univ. Station)
- 20~30 minute distance to downtown Seoul** (City hall, Dongdaemun, Myeong-dong, etc.)



Reasonable tuition fees, rich scholarships

- Tuition fee KRW 1.4 million (including cultural experience fee)
- Scholarships provided to students who excel in academics
- 50% scholarship for admission to undergraduate course after taking Kwangwoon University's Korean language course

Undergraduate-linked admission system

- Undergraduate admission is possible upon completion of Level 4 of Korean language course (but only for applicants)
- If enter Undergraduate course after completing level 4 or higher of Kwangwoon university's Korean language course, you can receive elective course credits (up to 6 credits)

Excellent Korean language education program

- Pre-training period before the start of the course
- Various activity education using learning contents / Systematic pronunciation education
- Free Korean alphabet classes, Clinic and Tutoring Program / Free TOPIK preparation class

Various university experience program

- Visiting university class / Meeting with senior / Major briefing session
- Movie screening / Library instructions / Welfare facility experience

1. Description

The Regular Program consists of six levels from level 1 to 6.

- 4 terms per year (spring, summer, fall and winter)
- 4 hours a day, 5 days a week: A total of 200 hours of lesson is provided
- Provides a variety of Korean culture experiences including taekwondo, traditional percussion quartet, K-pop dancing, visiting tourist attractions and so on.

- For students from countries such as Vietnam, Uzbekistan and Mongolia, **applications are closed 2 weeks earlier than above deadlines.**
- If applicant has a status of residence in Korea (if don't need D4 visa), **applications are closed 2 weeks in advance of semester begins.**
- Due to the different time required for each country to issue visas, please contact us as applications may be closed early.

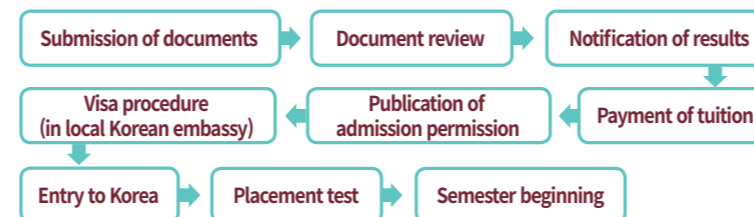
3. Class Organization

- Application fee : **KRW 50,000** (Non-refundable)
- Tuition fee : **KRW 1,400,000** (1term)
- ※ **Availabal variety of options from taking one semester to register for one year.**
- Textbook fee : Not included (around KRW 70,000 / term)

- Those who graduated from a high school or possess attainments equal to high school graduates.

7. Application Documents

For new applicants from abroad

※ Applicants who are planning to study for more than one term can apply for the D-4 General Student Visa

- 1) Application form, a statement of purpose
- 2) 1 passport photo
- 3) 1 copy of passport
- 4) 1 birth/family certificate
- 5) 1 copy of ID card of the applicant and his/her family
- 6) An original certificate of graduation from the last school attended
 - i) **Apostille**
(After notarizing Diplomas and Certificates of Graduation from the last school attended and then should confirm to consular representative at the consular office.)
Relevant country: Philippines, Indonesia, Bangladesh, Vietnam, Mongolia, Thailand, Pakistan, Sri Lanka, India, Myanmar, Nepal, Iran, Uzbekistan, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Ukraine, Nigeria, Ghana, Egypt, Peru.
 - ii) **Other Countries**
1 official certificate of graduation from the most recent school attended
- 7) 1 official academic transcript from the most recent school attended
- 8) A copy for each of the parent's certificate of employment/certificate of income (Must include the name, address, and contact information of the company)
- 9) An original certificate financial document - Over USD 10,000 (Bank statement under the applicant's name if it is under the parent's name, a notarized family certificate is required)
- 10) Korean guarantor's certificate of income and employment (notarized)
 - Individual applicant required to have a Korean guarantor

※ English translation notarization is required for any document not in English or Korean Language

For student who has a valid visa in Korea(those who do not need a D-4 visa)

- Application form, a statement of purpose (must be downloaded, and written and signed by the applicant)
- 3 passport photos
- 1 copy of passport
- 1 copy of certificate of graduation from the most recent school attended
- 1 copy of alien registration card (or copy of valid visa)
